Equipment: 1. Weapons, Masks, Electric Jackets, Body Wires, Mask Clips , Sabre Manchettes & Gloves are to be submitted to weapons check before the event, and will be checked again by the officiating referees before pool and DE bouts 2. Plastrons must be worn 3. No tracksuit pants may be worn. Breeches and long socks only 4. All fencers on the piste must have access to at least one spare working weapon, body wire and mask clip at the side of the piste 5. Electric jackets, mask bibs, sabre gloves & manchettes will be tested for dead spots.

Medals: will be awarded in All Age Groups and both Genders Gold x 1 Silver x 1 Bronze x 2 (if more than two pools) Veterans Medals - highest ranked veteran in each event No medal for Team event

Catering: The Cafeteria will be available at event

Remarks: Provinces are required to make referees available according to the number of entries they submit and in line with the Competition Regulations (See FFSA Website for details /documents/Competitions).Referees must be entered by the supplying Province on Ophardt by the closing date. Possible **U/13 mixed** epee competition on Sunday morning tbc.
