Notes

>> The above international point allocations are effective from 1 January 2019 and replace all previous versions.

>> Tier One International competitions mean FIE Satellite competitions, continental competitions (such as EFC competitions) and foreign national competitions. A foreign national competition (i.e. not provincial, club, etc) must have more than 50 fencers from clubs throughout the country or internationally participating.

>> Tier Two International competitions comprise FIE World Cup and Grand Prix competitions. Excluded are championships restricted to national selection, such as African Championships, World Championships and Commonwealth Fencing Championships.

>> A fencer must earn promotion from the poule stage of a Tier One or Tier Two competition in order to be awarded international points for that competition.

>> A fencer may substitute two local ranking competitions with international results. Please note this rule applies to fencers based overseas and in South Africa.

>> When reading the above table, reminder that in local South African competitions the following points allocation applies for places 5 to 16:

5th place = 12 points

6th place = 11 points

7th place = 10 points

8th place = 9 points

9th - 12th place = 7 points

13th - 16th place = 6 points
